


Kidneys in Situ Anterior View

Anterior Surface of Right Kidney





Intrarenal Arteries


Frontal Section of Left Kidney - Anterior View





Imagen general de la cortical. Numerosos glomérulos.




(1) Polo vascular (arteriola aferente) y urinario.

capa parietal y podocitos.




Glómérulo. Mácula densa (TCD).

TCP: eosinófilo, Luz estrecha




Estructura básica del glomérulo

Túbulo proximal a las 10_11 con chapa.




(3) Segmentos delgado y gruesos del Asa de Henle
